



Tulipa Little Beauty

A scented, cherry-red miniature with a delightful, white-edged, blue center, Little Beauty is wonderful in garden borders, rock gardens and underplantings. She is shown here in a signature blend with Tulipa Little Princess. Tulip Class: Species. Bulb size: 5 to 6 cm. Early May. HZ: 4-8. Height: 4".



Snow Crocus Mix

Our Snow Crocus Species Mixture is a wonderful blend of white, yellow, blue and violet varieties with grass-like foliage. They each have six-petaled flowers that open and close on early, sunny Spring days and grass-like foliage with narrow, median silvery stripes. Bulb size: 5 cm/up. Full to partial sunlight. Plant 4" deep and 3" to 4" apart. HZ: 4-8. Height: 4".



Starry Nights Ipheion Mix

This sweetly scented naturalizing mixture of The Spring Starflowers will yield a shades-of-blue carpet with intermittent marble-white twinkles. Bulb size: 4 cm/up. April/May. HZ: 5-9. Height: 3" to 6".



Paperwhite

This longtime favorite yields large trusses of fragrant, snow-white flowers with up to two stems per bulb. Flowers in four to six weeks once potted after the top growth is at least 1 1/2" tall. Best potted from mid-October to early March. Bulb size: 16/17 cm.



Allium Graceful Beauty

Circa 1857, this easy-growing American native has up to 3"-wide globes comprised of sparkling, starry white flowers with jewel-like, pale lavender stamens and very pale pink midveins. It is rabbit-, rodent- and deer-resistant yet adored by bees, butterflies and helpful pollinators. Plant Graceful Beauty in substantive clusters for the best effect. Bulb size: 6 cm/up. May/June. HZ: 4-8. Height: 12" to 16".



Southland Narcissus Mix

Composed for the warmer climates of horticultural zones 8 through 10, our special Southland Gold Medal Narcissus Mixture includes Trumpet Daffodil Dutch Master and Mando; Large Cupped Narcissi Fortissimo, Fortune, Ice Follies and Pink Charm; Double Narcissi Cheerfulness and Yellow Cheerfulness; Split-Cup Narcissus Orangery; Tazetta Narcissus Avalanche and Geranium; Jonquilla Narcissi Hillstar; and Poeticus Narcissus Actaea. Good for cooler climates as well, it thrives from horticultural zones 7 through 5 as well. Bulb size: DNII. April/May. HZ: 5-10. Height: 16" to 20".



Tulip Purple Prince

Purple Prince's large, lilac-purple flowers have a beet root-purple interior: it is the perfect counterpoint for Single Early Tulip Princess Irene. It's also gorgeous in our Princely Tulip Mixture. Single Early Tulips are known to be good for forcing. Please see the Tulip Forcing Tips below. Tulip Class: Single Early. Bulb size: 12 cm/up. Mid-April. HZ: 3-8. Height: 14".



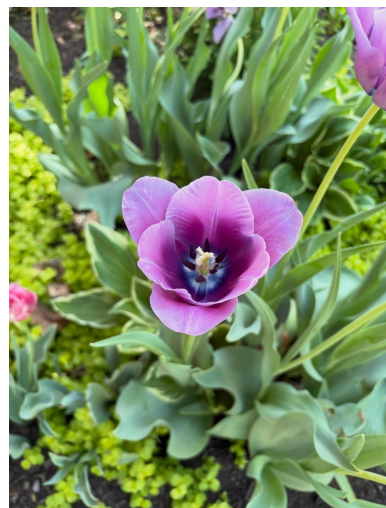
Tulip Sunny Prince

This cheerful Purple Prince sibling is the most luscious shade of pale lemon-yellow with a darker lemon interior. It is the sunshine in our Princely Tulip Mixture. Single Early Tulips are known to be good for forcing. Please see the Tulip Forcing Tips below. Tulip Class: Single Early. Bulb size: 12 cm/up. Mid-



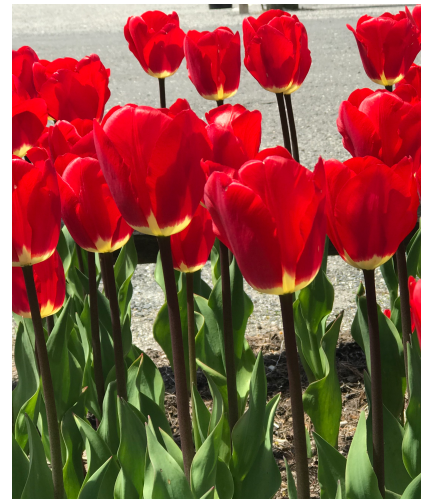
Tulip Menton

This beauty has varying shades of enchanting rose-pink with apricot-pink petal edges, a yellow base and a rather orange interior with white stripes. Depending on the light, the day and its whim, Menton exhibits varying levels of iridescent pinkness flushed apricot-salmon. Tulip Class: Single Late. Bulb size: 12 cm/up. Late May. HZ: 3-8. Height: 26".



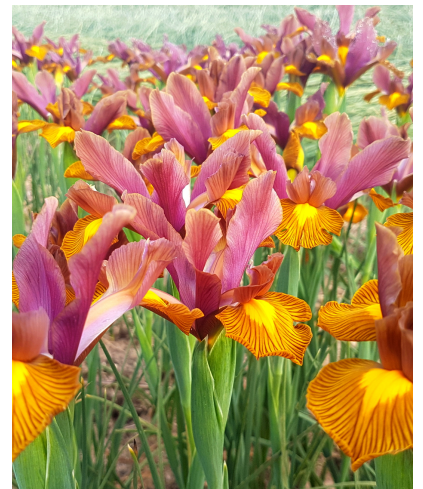
Tulip Bleu Aimable

An award-winning heirloom dating back to 1910, Bleu Aimable, a Blue Parrot sport, has a unique and exquisite form and is the most beautiful shade of deep lilac with a blue sheen, a magenta blush and a small interior white center swathed in blue. As you can see from our photos, in addition to become paler as its blooms mature, Bleu Aimable's coloration appears to change in different types of light. Tulip Class: Single Late. Bulb size: 12 cm/up. May. HZ: 3-8. Height: 24".



Tulip Fostery King

Technically classified as a Giant Darwin Hybrid but behaving more like a Single Late, Fostery King is resonant blue-scarlet with warm golden-red petal edges, a high-contrast white base and striking dark garnet stems. When the sun shines through its white base, it appears like spotlights in the garden. Tulip Class: Giant Darwin Hybrid. Bulb size: 12 cm/up. Bloom time: May. HZ: 3-8. Height: 24".



Dutch Iris Lion King

The Lion King Dutch Iris is not your typical variety! Butterscotch yellow petals with brown stripes are surrounded by a mane of purple and brown upright petals easily making this the the king of your Spring garden bed! Dutch Iris bloom in early Spring and are a beautiful addition to your Spring garden cut flower bouquet! For best results plant in full to part sun in well drained soil. Dutch Iris also prefer sunny, dry locations during the hot Summer months. Bulb size: 7 cm/up. May/June. HZ: 5-8. 18" to 22".
